# Joint curriculum

## Definition:

- Is the curriculum which set up compromisely by more than one university to achieve one set of learning outcome based on each university standard.
- Is one degree given by two or more higher education institutions together, for one study programme jointly developed and implemented by all participating higher education institutions
- **Is a curriculum jointly developed and implemented by two or more higher education institutions for one study program to achieve one set of learning outcomes which could be represented by one degree.**
