Background

- Udayana University has tried to contribute to educational process for international students.
- It started by offered private lesson on Indonesian and the Balinese languages for foreign students, researchers and professional who need to master the language for their work.
- Udayana University established BIPA in mid 1990s. BIPA = Indonesian language for Foreign Speaker.
- Now Unud has more six international programmes with or without credit transfer.
- Last year, 2015, Udayana University has 1400s foreign students.

BIPAS: Bali International Program for Asian Studies

- BIPAS is part of Asia Exchange programmes.
 - Asian Exchanges, initiated in 2007 in Finland.
 - AE send students to China, Thailand, Indonesia (Bali and Lombok).
 - BIPAS offers course for undergraduate and masters with credit transfer
 - BIPAS offers around 10 courses, each with world load of 139 which equivalent to 5 ECT

Joint Curriculum in Tourism

1. We will use BIPAS as a model for joint curriculum under ASEM Secretary initiative.
